Process



Get the trekking map at “Ninomaru-yakata”, the Tourism Interaction Base.



Start from the trailhead for each root. Shiroyama root is recommended for the beginners!



Check the red ribbons for Kanagoerenzan trekking course.

30mins slow walk from the trailhead. Enjoy the spectacular view below your eyes.



From Shiroyama to Yurino Mountain-top, it will take 60mins. Recommended for the intermediate level people.

BEST

Wide View Of Beppu-wan Bay! Spectacular 360-Degree View Trekking

Mountain range located in the northern part of Hiji is named Kanagoerenzan after its trail was so dangerous which made deer cry. Since its altitude is low, recommended trekking routes are maintained for the beginners and the intermediate level people. You can enjoy the walk with targeting red ribbon and the deer illustration.



Highly Recommended! Rhododendron kiusianum at the mountaintop of Mt. Kyodukayama (best time to see: mid of May and October)



Start with fresh water drew from the Yamada Spring. Nishikanagoedo (the Xavier road) -Kyodukayama root.
